By the Act of 6 & 7 William IV., c. 86, sec. 36, it is enacted, "That the Registrar-General shall cause to be made a Seal of the said Register Office, and the Registrar-General shall cause to be roaled or stamped thereon all Certified Copies of Births given in the said Office, and all Certified Copies of Entries, purporting to be Sealed or Stamped with the Seal of the said Office, shall be of any force or effect which is not Sealed or Stamped as aforesaid."
By sec. 37 of the same Act it is enacted, "That every general search of the Indexes shall be paid the sum of twenty shillings, and for every particular search the sum of one shilling, and for every Certified Copy the sum of two shillings and sixpence."
The Act 24 & 25 Vict., c. 86, sec. 86, enacts that whoever shall fraudulently detain, deface, or injure, or cause or permit to be so detained, defaced, or injured, any Entry relating to any Birth, Baptism, Marriage, Burial, or any other Entry, or shall forge or counterfeit the Seal of, or belonging to, any Registrar Office, or shall offer, utter, dispose of, or put off any such Register, Entry, Certified Copy, Certificate, or Seal, knowing the same to be false, forged, or altered, shall be guilty of Felony, and be liable to Penal Servitude, or to Imprisonment with Hard Labour.
