I Mary Fry of Dorset in the Parish of Cranborne in the County of Dorset do hereby this to be my last Will and Testament I give and bequeath to my son Simon Fry the sum of 1000 £ I appoint my Executor all my goods and chattels that belongs to me at my decease that is to say my funeral expenses to be paid as soon as possible and I give out of my property to my son Simon Fry ten pounds to my son James Fry ten pounds to Benjamin Fry ten pounds to Samuel Fry ten pounds to George Fry ten pounds to Charles Fry ten pounds at six months after my decease which is my last Will and Testament witness my hand this 29th day of Oct in the year one and eight hundred thirty and twenty eight

I Jane Faden of N^o 2 Charing Cross in the County of Middlesex do make this my last Will & Testament Nov^r 10th 1829 I desire that at my decease the annual interest of all the property of which I may then be possessed may be enjoyed by my dear Brother William Faden should he survive me during his natural life the sum of five thousand pounds that per cent interest stock which is exclusively my property though for my personal convenience is vested in the joint names of the said a a William Faden and myself I desire in the same way as my other property and I do make my Brother the said William Faden my Executor the Rev^d William Russell Rector of a a Stepperton Middlesex Executor of this my last Will & Testament On the decease of the said William Faden such that all my property may be given up in trust to my Executor the Rev^d William Russell of Stepperton to be distributed by him as follows

My Niece Maria Russell my Wife & Seal also my dear Sister India Stanlow to Sarah Stanlow or her surviving Children in equal portions one hundred pounds Sterling duty free for faithful services in the event of my being the survivor of any of the above parties my Will is that the surviving daughters of those parties may have the portion designed for their father or mother as the case may be equally divided among them should either of my two Daughters Ann & Maria Russell be the survivor of the other my Will is that the survivor receive the portion designed for the other in addition to her own the Residue of my property I give & bequeath to my said Executor the Rev^d Wm Russell of Stepperton
